MUSTANG CUP

A groundbreaking entry-level racing platform starting the spring of 2025, which bridges the gap between Ford Performance Driving Experiences and the Mustang Challenge. The Mustang Cup offers a professionally organized, club-level racing environment for novice and hobby racers to develop the fundamentals of organized racing on private USAC operated race weekends, alongside other USAC series and events.

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Ford Performance has created a pathway for Mustang enthusiasts (and established drivers) to reach the upper echelons of global sports car racing:

- 1. Starting in a Mustang Dark Horse at a Ford Performance driving experience, budding drivers are taught the fundamental techniques to drive a performance vehicle on the limit, within a safe environment.
- 2. From there, a driver can enter the cost-effective Mustang Cup and develop their race craft within a field of Mustang Dark Horse Rs.
- 3. The Mustang Challenge is the natural progression for drivers competing in the Mustang Cup (or the already seasoned racer) as it provides close, competitive racing in front of large crowds and streamed to a global audience. Series champions can accept a cash prize or a test in a Mustang GT4 car.
- 4. The Mustang GT4 is a step up from the Dark Horse R, with an increased number of racing-specific components competing against a field of other OEMs and hungry drivers vying to progress their careers.
- 5. The pinnacle of sports car racing, the trackbuilt Mustang GT3 features more power, more aero, more adjustable components and less overall weight. This is a V8 beast like no other and the car you will see competing in the 24 Hours at Daytona and 24 Hours of Le Mans.

03 MUSTANG CUP - SERIES OVERVIEW



Unique to Mustang Cup is the option of an optional two-driver format. Each race in a doubleheader format will count towards separate championships – the Miles Cup and Parnelli Cup – allowing two drivers to pursue separate championships or one driver to compete in both.

Drivers with a current club racing license from accredited sanctioning bodies will be recognized and issued a USAC Mustang Cup license. Drivers without a racing license, but who have track experience and wish to race in Mustang Cup, may obtain a nationally recognized club racing license from a number of accredited racing schools, in order to receive an equivalent USAC Mustang Cup license.

Mustang Cup offers flexibility to meet any racer's goals, whether aiming for advancement to a national championship series or competing at a regional level.
